

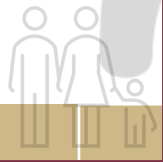


The examples of umbrella projects and sub-studies that follow are provided for illustration only. There may be others. Some common examples of umbrella projects include:

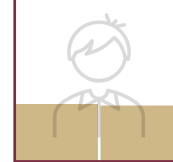

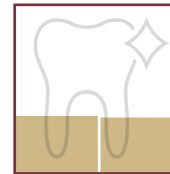

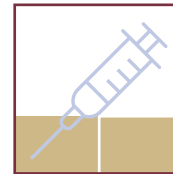

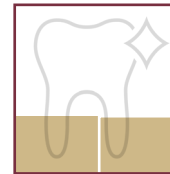
